Care center's gift shop raises top dollars

The de Snoep Winkel Gift Shop and Tea Room at Christian Health Care Center (CHCC) in Wyckoff recently made a check presentation in the amount of \$66,708 to the CHCC Foundation which represents the profits the shop made in 2014, and is the largest gift to date. The contribution went toward the CHCC Foundation's Annual Fund, which will be used to redesign and renovate CHCC's Heritage Manor Nursing Home. More than 3,000 square feet of space will be added to Heritage Manor West, and the current 8,000 square foot space will be totally renovated. This additional space and renovation will provide a setting which will meet the specific needs of this group of seniors, providing a home-like community which focuses on "person-and family-centered" care. This new model will continue to foster independence, collaboration, and freedom of choice.

"We are so blessed to have such a wonderful group of volunteers and staff who work in de Snoep Winkel Gift Shop and Tea Room," said Sandra Ondrof, Gift Shop manager. "The money raised is a tribute to their hard work and dedication to the shop and to Christian Health Care Center."
