2021 Highlights

Christian Health Care Center became Christian Health and unveiled a brand-new logo. Our name and visual identity changed, but our dedication to our mission, vision, and the delivery of compassionate care remains strong.

The Vista opened its doors, and residents moved in to the nearly 400,000-square-foot community, which features 161 finely detailed apartment homes overlooking the Ramapo Mountains.

The Growth for Generations campaign supported the expansion of Southgate Special Care, including four new beds and completely renovated resident rooms, common areas, and nurses station.

Bergen County's installation of a new traffic light at the intersection of Cedar Hill and Sicomac Avenues in Wyckoff introduced a new main entrance to Christian Health's Wyckoff/Hawthorne campus.

Douglas A. Struyk, CPA, LNHA, Christian Health President and CEO, was named chair of the New Jersey Hospital Association (NJHA) for 2021. He was the first chair in NJHA's history that was not an acute-care hospital CEO. NJHA is a not-for-profit trade organization committed to delivering support and services to New Jersey hospitals, health systems, and other health care providers and to providing quality, affordable, and accessible health care to state residents.

Summer Hill of Wayne apartments for adults aged 55 and older celebrated a 100% deficiency-free inspection by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

The Foundation's annual A Celebration of Excellence honored The Vista development team, who helped bring the vision for The Vista to life over two decades.

Christian Health celebrated 110 years of service to the community.

Christian Health welcomed three new trustees to its operating board: Rev. Richard A. Jones; Amy E. Shotmeyer, Esq., who also served on the Christian Health Foundation board; and Elizabeth Van Dyk, DNP, APN, FNP-C, ANP-BC.

The Bolger Foundation blessed Christian Health with a generous challenge grant to support the Growth for Generations campaign.

Hillcrest Residence for older adults celebrated a deficiency-free survey by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

Christian Health's 32nd Annual Golf Classic was held at Ramsey Golf & Country Club.

Longview Premier Assisted Living achieved the Advanced Standing status designation from the New Jersey Department of Health for the tenth year in a row – every year since the founding of the program!

Stephen J. Dumke, LNHA, FACHE, Christian Health Executive Vice President & COO, was installed as the chair of the board of trustees for LeadingAge New Jersey & Delaware. LeadingAge New Jersey & Delaware is the statewide association of not-for-profit senior care organizations and is dedicated to advancing quality aging services in New Jersey and Delaware through advocacy, education and fellowship.

The Foundation's virtual Simply Spring event was a "tasteful" evening, featuring at-home wine and beer tastings and delicious cuisine in support of the Annual Fund.

Heritage Manor Nursing Home and Southgate Special Care were recognized with Customer Experience Awards by Pinnacle Quality Insight.

The New Jersey Department of Health, in partnership with the New Jersey Hospital Association, once again awarded Christian Health's long-term-care communities and Ramapo Ridge Behavioral Health hospital with Antimicrobial Stewardship Recognition Awards.

For more than two decades, Southgate Special Care at Christian Health has provided compassionate skilled-nursing care for hundreds of older adults with behavior management needs related to dementia/Alzheimer's disease and other illnesses. In 2021, we began our project at Southgate Special Care to completely renovate and improve this special unit to better meet the changing and growing needs of our vulnerable residents.

In the spring, construction began with exterior excavations and the installation of footings and the new foundation. Southgate has now expanded by an additional 3,000 square feet to accommodate even more residents.

We are completely renovating all resident rooms and bathrooms, lounges and activity spaces, dining rooms, and nurses stations and installing new LED circadian throughout for Snoezelen therapy, quiet rooms, and common areas to help promote a calm and tranquil environment. We are also installing updated safety and security equipment, such as grab bars to prevent falls, a new nurse-call system, an upgraded door-safety and security system to reduce elopements, and more.

Our donors' generosity enabled Christian Health to continue our legacy to serve the community as we have for the last 110 years. Gifts to our 2021 Annual Fund made a significant impact on this project and directly supported the most vulnerable people in our community.

*In 2020 and 2021, Christian Health sought and received significant funds through various relief programs offered through the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), specifically under the CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Securities) Act Provider Relief Fund, and FEMA (Federal Management Agency) Disaster Relief Fund. These funds provided reimbursements for COVID-related losses in revenue resulting in a decrease in patient volume and services rendered, as well for COVID-related expenses including amplified PPE procurement, additional safety and testing equipment, and employee retention credit.

Fund-raising and public/private grants provided \$3,870,622 and \$1,080,800 during 2021 and 2020, respectively, that were used for capital improvements and other non-operating needs.

**The founding fathers of Christian Health established a facility that provided compassionate mental-health services for all individuals, regardless of ability to pay. Today, Christian Health continues this commitment based on an individual's circumstances. Collectively in 2020 and 2021:

- \$1,709,300 of charity care was provided for patients and clients of our mental-health services and individuals in our senior-life residences.
- Additionally, Christian Health absorbed \$15,301,600 due to the unpaid cost of Medicaid, public programs, and other indigent-care programs.
- For the broader community, Christian Health participated in health fairs, presentations, and workshops; invited various organizations to utilize Christian Health meeting space; and joined efforts to improve neighborhoods' overall environments. These activities equated to \$75,498.
- Collectively, non-billed care and services for the community totaled \$17,086,398.

The Vista Update

During 2021, Christian Health opened the doors of The Vista, its 161 apartment homes, and numerous features and amenities to its Charter and other future residents. Tax-exempt and bank financing primarily funded the costs of its planning, marketing, design and construction, along with financial support toward The Vista's first two years of operations as it approaches stabilized occupancy. Accordingly, The Vista's start-up results are excluded from the previously listed financial report.

As of December 31, 2021, The Vista was home to 98 residents in 82* apartment homes, with another 65 residents moving into an additional 43 apartment homes in 2022. The Vista is fully compliant with financing covenants governing occupancy and the use of cash from operations and reserves as of December 31, 2021. Satisfaction Surveys: How We Rate Among Those We Serve

A top priority for Christian Health is fulfilling the needs of our residents, patients, clients, consumers, and their families. Information collected through satisfaction surveys is an invaluable tool utilized to determine those needs – and if we are meeting or exceeding them. Survey data is reviewed and analyzed, and the feasibility of suggested modifications as guidance for implementing new practices and procedures is evaluated.

Surveys for Heritage Manor, Longview, Ramapo Ridge Behavioral Health, and Southgate Special Care were distributed and analyzed by national companies which conduct surveys in similar health-care organization. Satisfaction surveys for Evergreen Court, Hillcrest, Siena Village of Wayne, and Summer Hill of Wayne are conducted internally by our Service Excellence/Patient-Resident Experience Department. These results are computed as a score between 0 and 100.
