A hearth living room, complete with a double-sided fireplace leading into an all-new kitchen/dining area, and updated dining rooms make residents feel at home within the Center and are less institutional. In addition to making the Center feel more like home, the former large Nurses’ Station has been replaced with smaller offices to allow residents to use more space in common areas as they would in their own homes.
